Market news

Is this the year you will buy the vacation home of your dreams?

With all of the misfortune currently being experienced by the nation's home market you might be reluctant to even think about buying a home in Tahoe Donner. But I think there are a number of positive factors that should be considered before you make that final decision. They are:

1. Sales of Tahoe Donner single family homes have remained consistent for the past two years with 178 sold in 2006 and 177 in 2007. [See data](#)*
2. The trend line of the average sales price has increased gradually over the past 13 months.*
3. Current interest rates remain historically low.
4. The new stimulus package signed by President Bush significantly raises the ceiling on conforming rate loans from Truckee's present limit of \$417,000 to a proposed limit of \$558,750 (Nevada County ceiling). This will be in effect from 1 July through 31 December, 2008.
5. I believe Tahoe Donner still represents the best buy among the resort home communities of North Tahoe. This is based upon home selection and cost, accessibility to I-80, Truckee and major ski resorts, the variety and quality of family friendly amenities.

The club has regular meetings on the fourth Thursday of the month at OB’s Pub and Restaurant on Commercial Row in Truckee. Typically, it involves a short general meeting, a speaker and a great raffle. Prior to most meetings, a fly-tying session begins at 6:30 p.m., with the general meeting beginning at 7:30 p.m. The cost to join the club is \$35 for the first year for a new member, with renewals costing \$25 per year. A family can join for \$40 the first year, with renewals of \$30 per year thereafter.

New development planned for Donner Pass Rd.

The developers of a proposed project at the base of Northwoods Boulevard in Truckee say their plans may kick-start the revitalization of aging properties along Donner Pass Road. Called Royal Ridge, the mixed-use project is slated for an 8-acre parcel on the northeast corner of Northwoods Boulevard and Donner Pass Road (the original location of the Boice Countryside Realtors office). Plans call for about 23,000 square feet of commercial space, 48 town homes and 12 affordable condominiums, all of which could be completed by 2010.....(Greyson Howard the Nevada Appeal 2/18/2008)
